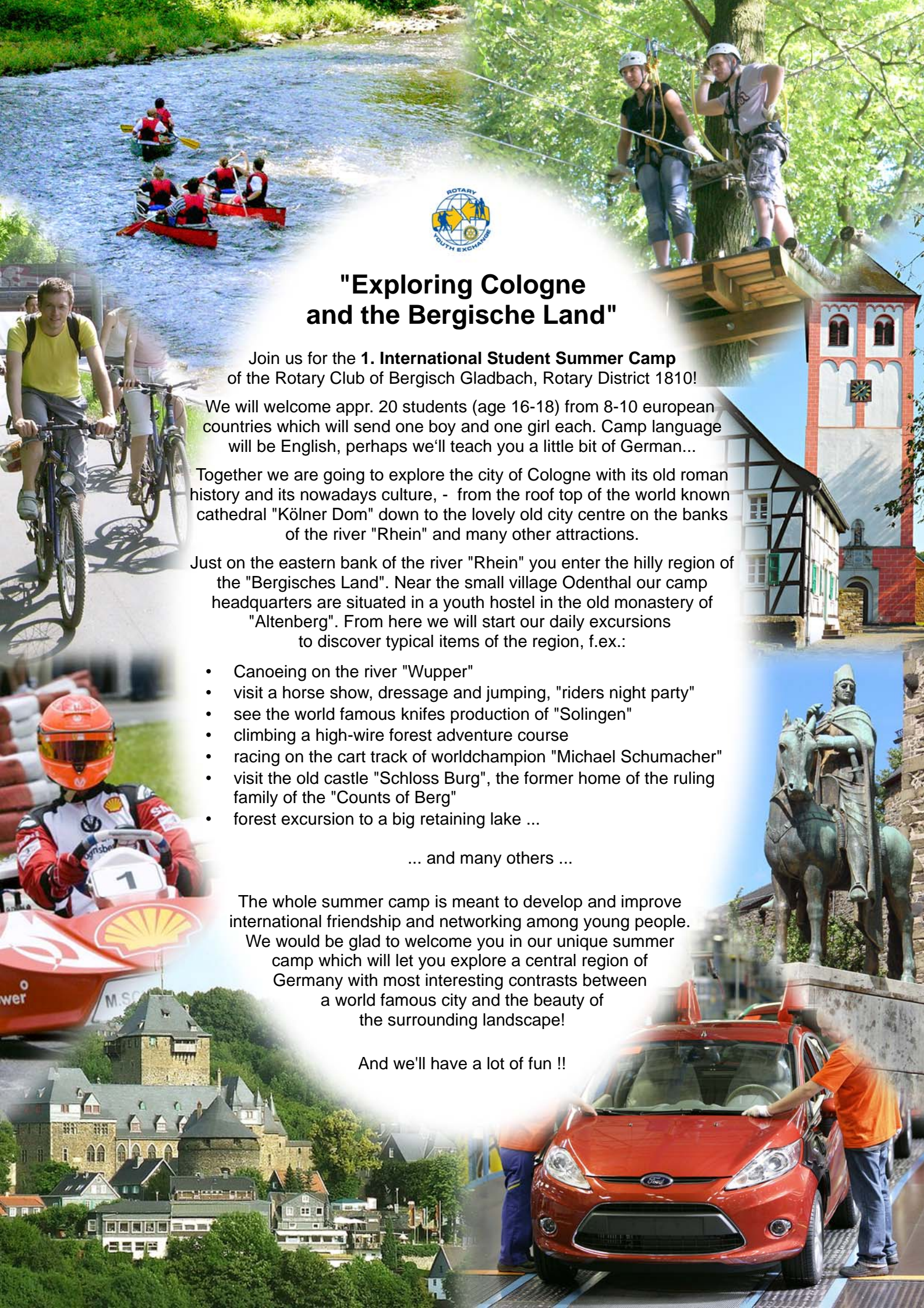
- Canoeing on the river "Wupper"

- forest excursion to a big retaining lake ...

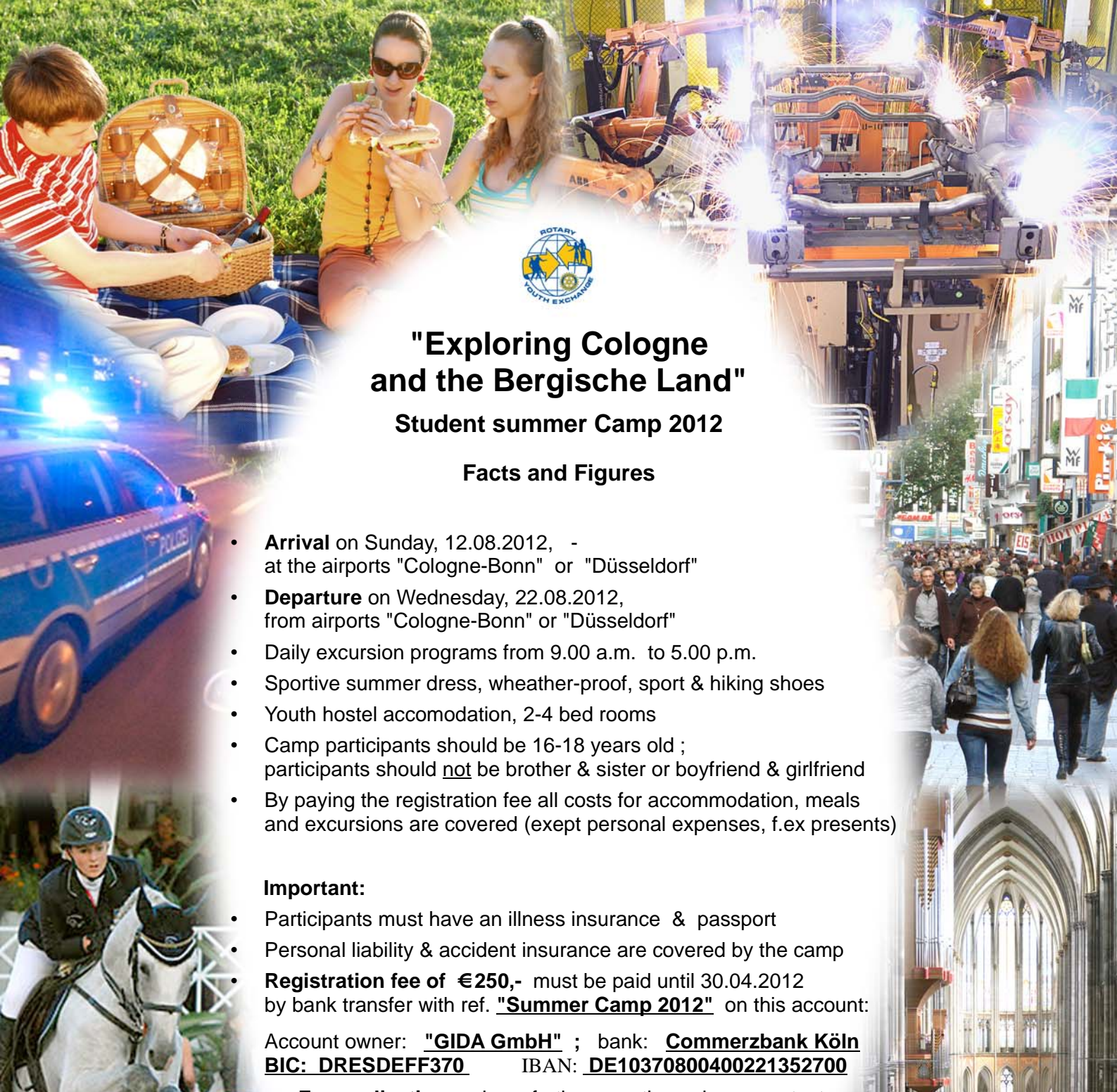
... and many others ...
